Ref : Opening liaisons between the Federal University of Santa Catarina, Brazil and the Cairo Museum, Egypt.

As a second presentation to the University of Cambridge I wish to present as a gift to Professor Troope a book of Collected Ghost Stories written by Montague Rhodes James, Vice Chancellor of Cambridge University from 1913 to 1915.

My first correspondence to you was delivered during October 2020 – since then I have completed a set of promotional videos and a document titled: 'Occulus Dei – Establishing Embassy to Significant Religious Objects (SRO) Ark of the Covenant, Holy Grail and Caravan of Treasures'.

Prior to deportation from Brazil in March 2012 whilst incarcerated in the state penitentiary of Santa Catarina, I was visited by Captain Carlos Lima – Public Relations Officer to the Brazilian army he being accompanied by a Catholic Priest. Captain Lima kindly returned conceptual artwork for proposed gameshow 'Time Tunnel – Atari Alliance' with which I returned to England. Captain Lima has since moved into politics and a copy of the CD enclosed is being posted to him.

The book of ghost stories came into my possession during lockdown as Oxfam in Huntingdon gave away free books from a box on their doorstep. One story features a priestly character seeking guidance by flicking through a Holy Bible and taking note of three separate passages selected by chance.

During my stay in the state penitentiary I drafted an autobiographical tale of how life's path had taken me from childhood in a Cambridgeshire village to a dingy Brazilian prison cell. The story revolved around how exposure to key passages of printed text guided life's journey – one example being as a sixth form student a prospectus for Leeds University took me to a period of life in Yorkshire.

While employed in Gatwick as a Design Engineer for a French Flight Simulator company 1998/1999, three books purchased from a Clapham Junction bookstore guided me to archaeological discoveries on Ilha Santa Catarina (Florianopolis) – 'The Hyrum Key' (origins of Scots Freemasonry), 'The Fire Within' (Mexican Shamanism) and 'Foders Guide to Brazil' (taking me to Joaquina Beach – Brazil's premier Surf spot overlooked by a mountain carved with pyramid type geometry).

Sixteen years have now passed since a credit card was used to initiate a studios project in Lagoa de Conceicao, Florianopolis. Receiving monthly Universal Credit payments, I am currently being pressurised by Huntingdon Jobcentre Work Coach – Lucy Mapplethorpe – to find paid employment. With the presentation provided I am requesting that your office take a positive interest in discoveries and consider pointing me in the right direction to continue my work.
